On October 12, 2021, Mireille Laroche joined the Office of the Chief Human Resources Officer at the Treasury Board of Canada Secretariat as an Assistant Deputy Minister. She is leading the People and Culture (P&C) sector.

Prior to this appointment, Mireille spent seven years at the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA), including the last three years as the Assistant Commissioner of the Service, Innovation and Integration Branch, Chief Service Officer, and Chief Data Officer. During this time, Mireille notably led the development and implementation of a new Agency vision and People-First Philosophy and led the Agency's transformation agenda.

Mireille joined the CRA in September 2014 as Deputy Assistant Commissioner of the Collections and Verification Branch. She became the Assistant Commissioner of the Appeals Branch on April 1, 2016.

Prior to joining the CRA, Mireille held various senior management positions at Employment and Social Development Canada, including acting Assistant Deputy Minister of the Processing and Payment Services Branch at Service Canada and Director General of the Canada Pension Plan and Old Age Security Directorate. From 2011 to 2013, she served as Director General of Employment Insurance Policy with Employment and Social Development Canada.

Mireille began her career in the public service in 1996 with the Department of Finance Canada, where she worked on various economic and fiscal issues.

Mireille holds a Master of Arts in Economics from Queen's University and a Bachelor of Social Sciences with a specialization in Economics and Political Science from the University of Ottawa.
