# A Key Initiative of the National IP Strategy

- Budget: \$85.3 million over 5 years (and ongoing funding) to help innovators understand, protect and access Intellectual Property (IP)
- Objective: To help Canadian innovators reach commercial success, and further discovery, and create middle-class jobs by protecting their ideas and ensuring they reap the full rewards of their inventions and creations
- A number of initiatives built around 3 pillars:
  - 1. IP Awareness, Education & Advice
  - 2. Strategic IP Tools for Growth
  - 3. IP Legislation

# It can be Difficult for Canadian Businesses to Find Useful Technologies

- Canada's public sector is a key **source of technologies** that can be used by innovative SMEs to grow and become more competitive.
- Most SMEs do not know where to look – even fewer have the **time and resources** to track down these technologies to further their business needs.
- Information on these technologies may be scattered across various platforms, making it difficult for businesses to **search for specific solutions**.
- Even after discovering a technology with potential, businesses may not be able to **find someone to initiate discussions**.
- **ExploreIP is a new, better way** for businesses to find relevant technologies.

- Launched in August 2019
- A listing of public sector owned patents, with direct contact information
- User-friendly interface allows users to discover licensable inventions through:
  - Key word searches
  - Technology categories
  - Research organizations
  - Interactive diagrams

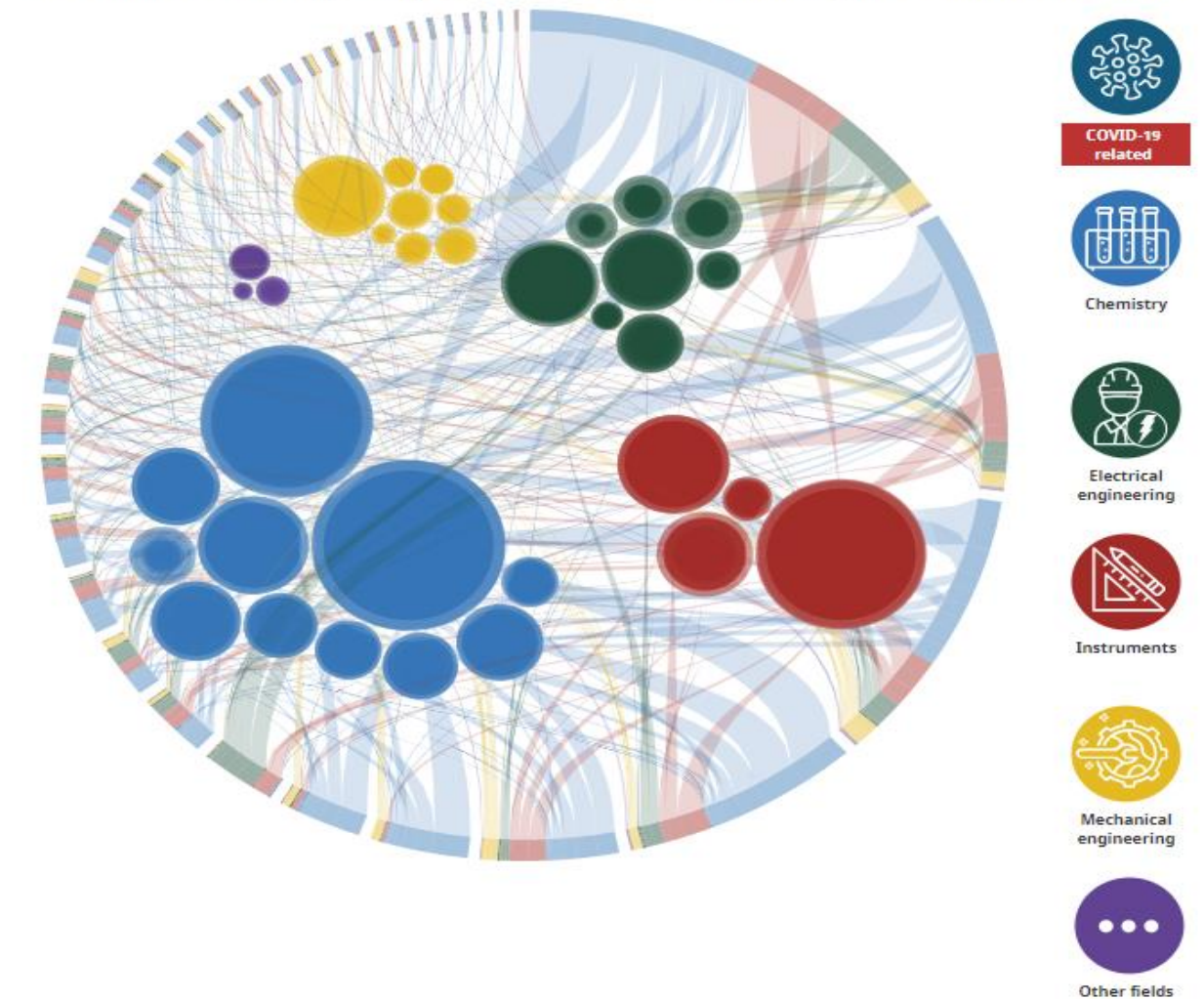
