About the Award

1. About the Judy Booth Award for Excellence in Access to Information and Privacy

The Judy Booth Award (the Award) recognizes public servant(s) for outstanding achievement in improving service delivery, transparency and collaboration related to access to information and privacy (ATIP) in the Government of Canada.

The award will be presented at a later date (to be announced).

2. Nomination Process

Nominations will be open from Thursday, July 17, 2025, to Monday September 29, 2025. To nominate an individual or a team, please complete the nomination form.

Any employees of institutions under the *Access to Information Act* (ATIA) and the *Privacy Act* (PA) may submit a nomination.

All nominations must be endorsed by a peer or a senior leadership before being submitted. It cannot be the same as the nominator.

3. Selection process

Once nominations have closed, the selection committee will review all the nominations received and rate them against the evaluation criteria. The selection committee will evaluate nominations solely based on the information in the nomination form. It will not look at any other information, nor links provided in submission.
