In her previous role as Senior Director of Policy and Research, she led the modernization of the *Official Languages Act* and worked with community, government and academic partners.

As Director of Interdepartmental Relations and Accountability, she led the first-ever progress report to the Clerk on the implementation of the recommendations of the Report on Language of Work in the Federal Public Service in partnership with TBS, PCO and Justice Canada.

Prior to joining PCH, Sarah held several positions with Employment and Social Development Canada, Health Canada and the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages, where she developed a second language learning strategy.
