# LIFTING AS YOU LEAD MENTORING CIRCLES (LLMC) PROGRAM

Are you looking for a way to grow? Join a mentorship circle today to prepare for the future. This is a ten week program to connect deeply with others, elevate your knowledge and networks, and inspire others to help facilitate the change towards a more inclusive workplace.

### **OVERVIEW**

Our Mentoring Circles include leaders across the Government of Canada from all levels. Connect and develop with colleagues who share common interests and learning objectives through this innovative space. This program will consist of five Circle sessions and five optional enrichment sessions. Circle members (6-10 participants per group) will tackle five topics from personal to professional. Opportunities to lead the bi-weekly Circle will provide members with a chance to build confidence, improve leadership skills, and engage in career development through active facilitation. The optional information sessions are an opportunity to learn some practical steps you can take as you move forward in your career and will be related to the content of the previous week's Circle.
