Vision for the conference

Forward-looking, with an open and horizontal approach to connect data communities, and respond to the strategic needs of the Government of Canada and public service

Overarching theme (TBC) An Integrated Data Community for Building Back Better

The theme is in alignment with:

- Priority of recovery highlighting federal and provincial governments' commitment to make positive systemic changes through better data
- COVID 19 context recognize issues around data gaps, data quality, and data sharing among jurisdictions
- Digital infrastructure transformation driving government's top priorities on data security, integrity, and privacy
- Ethical data standards and practices guiding how public service uses data
- Value of data assets amplified through effective governance and partnerships, and by connecting data communities

Representatives from an inter-departmental advisory committee will:
