Provincial and territorial restrictions

There are currently travel restrictions and exemptions when moving between some provinces and territories.

By region


Atlantic provinces

Atlantic provinces are restricting entry for people from other provinces and territories. You may require documents to declare your arrival.

- New Brunswick
- Newfoundland and Labrador
- Nova Scotia
- Prince Edward Island

Provincial restrictions feedback

Many provincial questions are posted on pages other than the provincial page - since changes to page on Dec 23. - not seeing links to Provincial and territorial restrictions?

- From Flying in Canada (43)
- From Mandatory isolation (50)
- From Travel restrictions in Canada (95)

Many questions are about whether travel is permitted between provinces or interprovincially:

- We live in Prince George BC and want to visit Grande Prairie AB is this allowed?
- I live in Sask and want to know if I can travel to Alberta?
- There is lots of information about flying into Canada but no clear info about within.

Or whether quarantine/isolation is required between provinces or interprovincially:

- If someone moves from Alberta to Ontario. Do they have to self isolate?
- Do you isolate after travelling region to region in ON?
- When traveling from another province do you have to isolate for 14 days?

People differentiate between driving and flying, and changing provincial restrictions:

- I'm unsure about driving from one province to another.
- Is it allowed to drive between Ontario and Québec during current lock down?

Options for helping Canadians understand jurisdictions

- State outright that it's provincial and don't provide ANY advice
 - a. Provide provincial links in list or dropdown

2. Use a templated approach to pull in key answers and link to province


Given how quickly travel restrictions and vaccine distribution are changing, we are trying Option 1 - no advice.







- 2899 comments from Canadians since Dec 7, 2020 (about 71 a day)










Publish the data on vaccines. Ordered with delivery dates. Delivered to provinces. Get transparent instead of covering up


