Collaborating digitally involves “working out loud,” where employees can see and benefit from each others’ work.

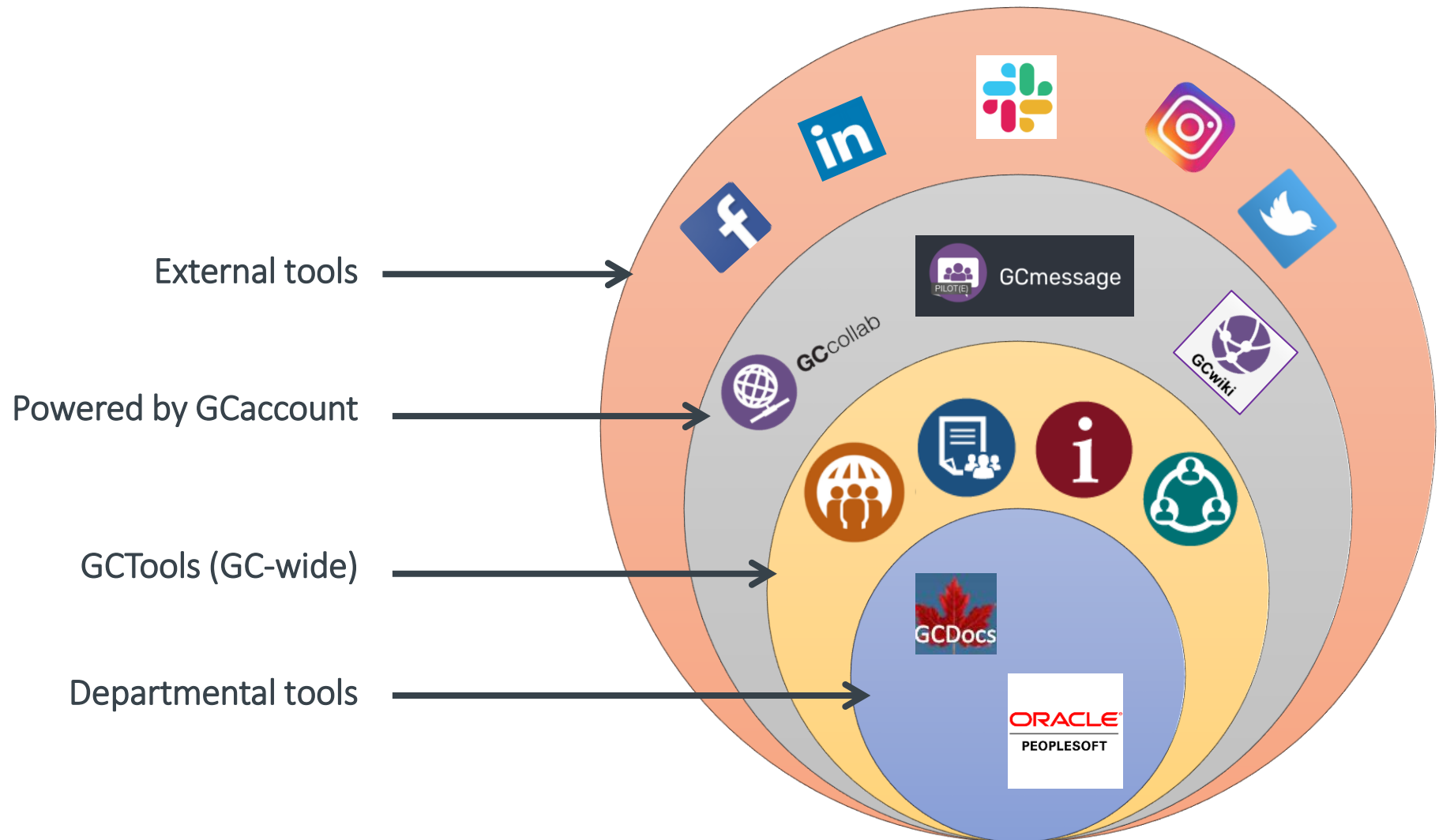

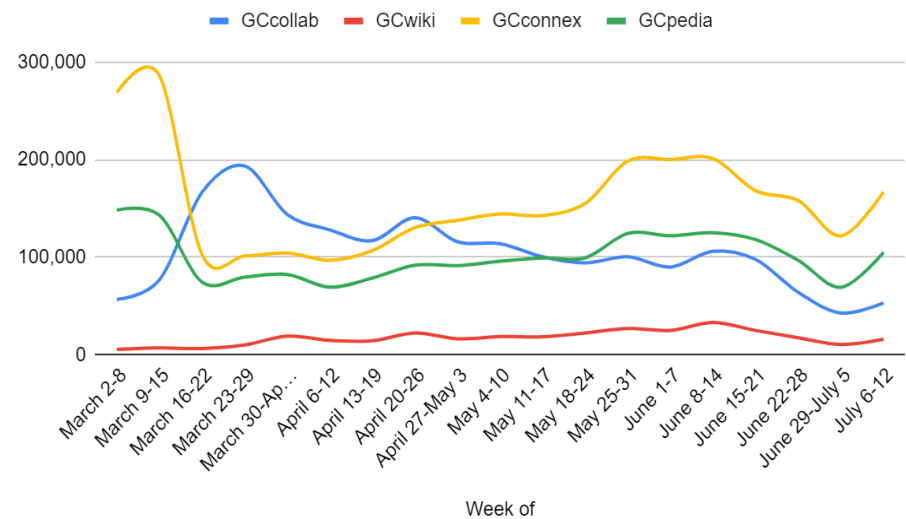

### CFR Governance Structure

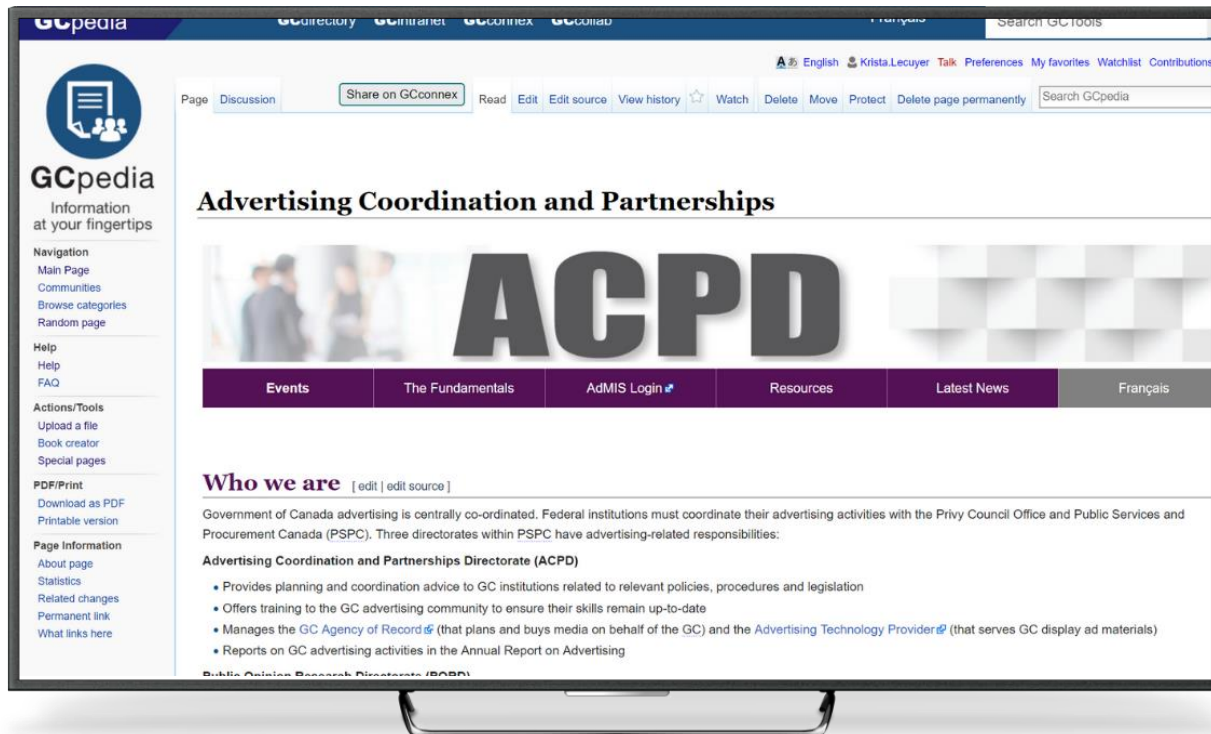
