LEADERSHIP

Acts as a leader in the promotion of both official languages (OL), thereby fostering a change in culture and creating a work environment conducive to the effective use of both OL.

CREATIVITY

Creatively develops initiatives and implements innovative projects or other measures that yield concrete results in the promotion of official languages.

EFFORTS

Has made significant efforts to learn either OL as their second, third or more language, to maintain it, and to transmit its culture within the workplace.

- Mandated by the ADM
- Coordination of activities
- Support to the designated Official

Mandate

- **Promote** the integration of obligations arising from the *Official Languages Act*
- Oversee the implementation of the departmental official languages policy and the action plan
- Identify the challenges, priorities and issues of their branch/sector pertaining to language of work
- Propose strategies fostering the creation of a work environment that is more conducive to the use of both official languages
- **Determine** opportunities or initiatives for raising the level of bilingualism
- **Identify** best practices internally and in other organizations and encourage their use
