Various Workpoints

- Workpoints to support a wide variety of activities and varying degrees of social connection or individual concentration depending on the work zone.
- Individual and collaborative workpoints.
- Open, semi-enclosed, or enclosed workpoints.
- Various sizes and configurations.
- Different workpoints can be used throughout the day.



Adaptable Workstations

- All workstations have adjustable furnishings and equipment.
- Ergonomic chairs, standing desks and two computer screens in workspaces are available to help improve posture and instill healthy work habits.
- If specific requirements are needed, additional accommodations can be offered to employees through the duty to accommodate requirements and on a case-by-case basis.



Open and Bright Spaces

- Bright, open spaces with plenty of natural light and greenery.
- Collaboration spaces with a relaxed atmosphere makes it easier to casually connect with colleagues. .



Enhanced Technology

- Universal docking stations with a single cable to connect departmental laptops to a screen, network and other functions.
- Wi-Fi available throughout the workplace allows stable and secure connectivity while moving between different workpoints.
- Large video screens, projectors, interactive technology and wireless connectivity in collaborative spaces.



Lockers

• Lockers are available to store personal items securely.



New Booking System

- All ESDC Workplaces are included in the ESDC Workspace Management System.
- The ESDC Workspace Management System allows workstations to be booked, but the system will evolve to meet the needs of other workspaces (collaboration rooms, meeting rooms, etc.).
- Boardroom and meeting room booking functions as well as booking from a mobile device are in development.

Various Working Zones

- **Quiet Zone**: includes open, semi-enclosed, and enclosed individual workpoints, and encourages individual and focused work.
- Transitional Zone: for less intense concentration; open individual and group workpoints; semi-enclosed collaboration and support spaces.
 Allows collaboration with a small number of colleagues.
- Interactive Zone: encourages socialization and group collaboration; a variety of group workpoints located away from the Quiet Zone.



More Collaborative Spaces

- Promotes spontaneous interaction, sharing ideas, and collaborative activities.
- Shared monitors, smart screens, writeable surfaces, and reconfigurable furnishings.
- Offers a variety of open, closed, formal and informal meeting spaces.
