WHAT IS THE OLRRE?

This exercise is a legislative requirement undertaken every ten years following the publication of the linguistic data from the decennial census. Federal institutions reapply the *Official Languages (Communications with and Services to the Public) Regulations* to confirm or modify the linguistic designation of federal points of service.




