


Controls must be in place to <u>limit</u> access to personal information for both physical security and in information technology:



Building and floor access



Filing cabinets and paper files



Role-based network and software access



Passwords and encryption on devices

THE MOST COMMON TYPE OF PRIVACY BREACH IS THE UNAUTHORIZED DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

LIMITING ACCESS TO PERSONAL INFORMATION IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF PREVENTING PRIVACY BREACHES
