HOUSING DATA INTEROPERABILITY

Housing data exists, but it is fragmented.

This is (merely) annoying for experts, but it effectively prevents a huge number of non-experts from meaningfully leveraging data.

Interoperability is a technical, epistemological, and political problem.

HOUSING DATA INTEROPERABILITY

We should still think about getting new housing data (e.g. I'm interested in property ownership!), but first....

Let's make sure we take advantage of all the data that we have (from AVAILABLE to ACCESSIBLE).

That means: break down data silos, solve spatio-temporal comparison issues, and invest in public education.
